Jane Austen was an English novelist known primarily for her six major novels. Austen's storylines often explore the dependence of women on marriage in the pursuit of favorable social standing and economic security. Her works critique the typical sensible novels of the second half of the 18th century and are part of the transition to 19th century literary realism.

Her writing was pretty controversial because of her way of humor and social commentary which led to the criticism of critics, scholars and popular audiences alike.

Austen has inspired many critical essays and literary anthologies. Furthermore she made a big impact with her novels being the inspiration of many great movies in modern times.

Jane Austen's most famous novels are *Sense and Sensibility, Pride and Prejudice, Persuasion, Mansfield Park, Emma and Northanger Abbey*.
